PONCE CLAIMS THAT ON AVERAGE 560 WOMEN DISAPPEAR ANNUALLY AND THAT LAST YEAR VIRTUALLY ALL OF THEM WERE THE 1999 STATISTICS FOR SAFELY RETURNED TO THEIR FAMILIES. HOMICIDES COMMITTED AGAINST WOMEN ARE, HOWEVER, DIFFICULT TO VERIFY. ACCORDING TO STATE FIGURES OBTAINED ONLY AFTER POSTQS REPEATED REQUESTS, THERE WERE 18 HOMICIDES INVOLVING WOMEN IN 1999 WITH 15 OF THESE CASES ALLEGEDLY SOLVED.
