1. SUMMARY. KNOWN AS ONE OF THE MOST DANGEROUS CITIES IN MEXICO, CIUDAD JUAREZ APPEARS TO BE EXPERIENCING A DECREASE IN CRIME, ACCORDING TO COMPETING STATISTICS THE STATE GOVERNOR AND CITY UNCLASSIFIED

2. CRIME RATES IN JUAREZ ON DECLINE. FOR A LONG TIME, JUAREZ HAS SUFFERED FROM A REPUTATION FOR RAMPANT CRIME. ACCORDING TO THE COLEGIO DE LA FRONTERA NORTE, THE ANNUAL HOMICIDE RATE IN JUAREZ PEAKED IN RECENT YEARS AT 62 MURDERS PER 100,000 IN 1996. THE FOLLOWING YEAR THAT RATE DROPPED TO 49 MURDERS PER 100,000. (AT PRESENT NO HOMICIDE STATISTICS ARE AVAILABLE FOR 1998.) THESE FIGURES ARE STILL

SIGNIFICANTLY HIGHER THAN THOSE OF JUAREZQ SISTER CITY, EL PASO, TEXAS. IN 1997, THE HOMICIDE RATE IN EL PASO WAS 24 PER 100,000 AND DROPPED TO 17 PER 100,000 IN 1998, ACCORDING TO THE UNIFORM CRIME REPORT PUBLISHED BY THE FBI. OTHER TYPES OF CRIME SUCH AS AGRRAVATED ASSAULTS AND REPORTED SEXUAL ABUSE ARE ALSO CLAIMED TO BE ON THE DECLINE IN JUAREZ.

3. STATE GOVERNOR AND CITY MAYOR COMPETE FOR TAKING CREDIT. THE PRI-GOVERNOR OF CHIHUAHUA, PATRICIO MARTINEZ, AND THE PAN-MAYOR OF JUAREZ, GUSTAVO ELIZONDO, INTRODUCED SEPARATE PLANS TO ADDRESS PUBLIC SAFETY. THE GOVERNOR INTRODUCED QZERO TOLELRANCEQ SIX MONTHS AGO, FOLLOWED BY THE MAYORQS QSAFE JUAREZQ ANNOUNCEMENT LAST MONTH. MANY CITY OFFICIALS SEE FEW DIFFERENCES BETWEEN THE TWO PLANS, WITH SUPPORT FOR EACH PLAN TENDING TO FALL ALONG PARTY LINES. THE INITIATIVES UNCLASSIFIED

ARE SIMILAR IN SEVERAL RESPECTS: RESTRICTION OF

TO THE STATE CONGRESS FOR HARSHER CRIMINAL SENTENCES.
SOME OFFICIALS SUGGEST THAT ONE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN THE
PLANS IS FOCUS. THE MAYORQS PLAN OFFERS PREVENTION
PROGRAMS AIMED AT JUVENILE DELINQUENCY WHILE THE
GOVERNORQS PLAN TARGETS INVESTIGATION, CONSISTENT WITH
PRESIDENT ZEDILLOQS NATIONAL EFFORTS TO CURB CRIMES OF
ANY KIND AND AT ALL LEVELS OF ENFORCEMENT.

- 4. CRACKDOWN ON BARS AND OTHER SOURCES OF CRIMINAL ACTIVITY. FOR THE FIRST TIME IN THE HISTORY OF JUAREZ, BARS ARE BEING SHUT DOWN BY THE STATE, SPECIFICALLY BY THE INTERIOR DEPARTMENT OF GOBERNACION. BOTH GOVERNOR MARTINEZ AND MAYOR ELIZONDO URGED THESE CLOSINGS WITH THE CITY COUNCIL VOTING UNANIMOUSLY IN SUPPORT. PRESSURE GREW WHEN IT WAS LEARNED THAT SOME BARS SOLD DRUGS. ONE DRUG SEIZURE EVEN INVOLVED A CITY POLICE OFFICER WHO STOLE FIREARMS FROM HIS STATION TO SELL AT THE BARS. NIGHTCLUBS AND LIQUOR STORES ARE ALSO FACING GREATER SCRUTINY FOR VIOLATING THE NIGHTLY CURFEW AND FOR SELLING TO UNDERAGE PATRONS. AGO, CITY COUNCIL RECOMMENDED OFFICIALLY TO THE STATE GOVERNMENT THE SHUTDOWN OF 23 BARS. RAUL GARCIA ACOSTA, CITY COUNCIL MEMBER AND FORMER CHAIRMAN OF THE JUAREZ PAN PARTY, STATED THAT EFFORTS TO CLOSE ADDITIONAL NON-COMPLYING BARS WILL PROCEED FORTHWITH.

6. COMMENT: TWO AREAS OF CRIME STILL CAUSE MUCH CONCERN. FIRST, DRUG-RELATED VIOLENCE IS WIDELY BELIEVED TO GO UNDETERRED, SUCH AS SHOOTINGS INVOLVING RIVAL GANGS. ACCORDING TO THE OFFICE OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND CITIZEN PROTECTION, THERE ARE OVER 100 GANGS IN JUAREZ WITH ALMOST FOUR THOUSAND MEMBERS. THE FEDERAL ATTORNEY GENERALQS OFFICE HAS RECENTLY DRAWN CRITICISM FOR ITS EFFORTS OR LACK THEREOF. TWO WEEKS AGO, DEA OFFICIALS IN EL PASO ANNOUNCED THE LARGEST COCAINE SEIZURE OF THE YEAR TO THE SURPRISE OF A LOCAL REPRESENTATIVE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL. JUAREZ HAS 40 SUCH OFFICIALS AND ONLY 16 OF THEM ARE DEPLOYED IN DRUG TRAFFICKING INVESTIGATION. SECOND, THE MURDERS OF APPROXIMATELY 200 WOMEN -- MANY OF WHOM WERE YOUNG MAQUILADORA WORKERS -- IN JUAREZ SINCE 1993 CONTINUE TO DRAW INTERNATIONAL ATTENTION. BUT SINCE THE ARREST OF SEVERAL LOCAL BUS DRIVERS IN MARCH, SUCH ATTACKS HAVE ALL BUT CEASED. EAGER TO SUBSTANTIATE THE SUCCESS OF HIS QZERO TOLERANCEQ PLAN, THE GOVERNOR MADE PUBLIC LAST MONTH STATISTICS SHOWING LOWER CRIME RATES IN JUAREZ. SINCE TAKING OFFICE IN OCTOBER 1998, THE GOVERNOR CLAIMS THAT HOMICIDES INVOLVING WOMEN HAVE UNCLASSIFIED

SUBSTANTIAL DROPS IN KIDNAPPINGS (75 PERCENT), BANK ASSAULTS (46.2 PERCENT), AND REPORTS OF STOLEN VEHICLES (26.2 PERCENT) WERE ALSO IN SPITE OF THE ABOVE-CITED REDUCTION IN THE CITED. CRIME RATE, PUBLIC CONTEMPT FOR THE POLICE IS A FACT OF LIFE IN JUAREZ. POLICE COMMISSIONER BENAVIDES TOLD THE CONSUL GENERAL RECENTLY THAT HIS BIGGEST PROBLEM IS SIMPLY FINDING RECRUITS WILLING TO JOIN THE POLICE FORCE. IN SPITE OF SALARY INCREASES, THE CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW POLICE ACADEMY, AND PROVISION OF PROFESSIONAL TRAINING, ATTRITION USUALLY OFF-SETS RECRUITMENT, THEREBY INHIBITING ANY GROWTH IN THE FORCE. CIUDAD JUAREZ IS CONSERVATIVELY ESTIMATED TO HAVE 1.5 MILLION RESIDENTS. WHILE THE TOTAL MUNICIPAL FORCE CONSISTS OF 800 POLICE OFFICERS, WITH ONLY 250 OR SO ON PATROL AT ANY GIVEN TIME. THE INTENSELY POLITICAL WAR CARRIED ON BETWEEN GOVERNOR MARTINEZ AND MAYOR ELIZONDO ALSO INFLUENCES THEIR DEPLOYMENT OF CRIME STATISTICS, WHOSE RELIABILITY IS DIFFICULT TO ASSESS. POST IS WORKING WITH A VARIETY OF OFFICIAL, UNIVERSITY AND NGO SOURCES TO CLARIFY THE CRIME PICTURE AND WILL REPORT FURTHER AS WE LEARN MORE. END COMMENT.
